



Cape Point & Winelands



We drive along Chapman's Peak which offers amazing photo opportunities. The steep cliffs plunging into the icy Atlantic Ocean, and tumultuous waves crashing against the rocks is an amazing sight. Subject to the pass being open.



Our tour takes us to the spectacular Cape of Good Hope Reserve also known as Cape Point where many of the Cape's wild animals can be spotted. You can also take the funicular to the lighthouse (funicular for own account +- R80.00). Here you will see where the Indian and Atlantic Oceans meet and you will also see False Bay.



We drive through quaint Simonstown and view the Penguin Colony at Boulders Beach (own account +- R80.00).

Then we head to the V&A Waterfront for a quick stop. Guests can purchase food and refreshments (own account) before we head out to Stellenbosch. Then we head out to the Winelands and enjoy a cellar tour followed by a cheese and wine tasting at one of our magnificent Wine Estates.

Our tour continues into the historic town of Stellenbosch with its picturesque white gabled Cape Dutch architecture. The pretty streets and lanes are lined with old oak trees. The town boasts a large university with energetic students offering a contrast to the old-world feel of the town.

If time permits our guide will choose a second estate for another wine tasting before heading back to your hotel.
